Skin, chest: MALIGNANT MELANOMA, INVASIVE

Malignant melanoma, invasive, superficial spreading type.

Clark level: IV.

Breslow thickness: 1.3 MM.

Radial growth phase: Present.

Vertical growth phase: Present.

Ulceration: Not identified.

Mitotic figures: 5 /10hpf.

Regression: Not identified.

Angiolymphatic invasion: Not identified.
